# THE INNER CITY CYCLING CONNECTION, INC. JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL & HIGH SCHOOL BICYCLE RACING MEET AND FESTIVAL

## **BICYCLE RACING MEET & FESTIVAL MISSION:**

"To Have Students, Their Parents, and School Administrator Be Informed and Entertained About Cycling By Doing."

Inner City Cycling Connection, Inc. (IC3), a 501(c3) non-profit organization formed in 2005, has organized a junior high school and high school bicycle racing meet and festival. This racing meet will be on Hoover Street in Los Angeles between 47<sup>th</sup> Street and 49<sup>th</sup> Street. The festival and post-race ceremony will be held at the same location at the Julian C. Dixon Park | 4800 South Hoover Street | Los Angeles, CA 90037. The date for this event is tentatively set for Saturday September 26, 2020. The racing meet will be from 8am to 12pm, while the festival will be from 12pm to 5pm. Participating school registration will be from 7am to 8am. Street closures between 47<sup>th</sup> and 49<sup>th</sup> Street will be from 7am to 12pm.

At the end of the bicycle race and festival, a junior high will be crowned LA Fastest Cycling Champion boys and LA Fastest Cycling Champion girls. Likewise, a high school will be crowned LA Fastest Cycling Champion boys, and LA Fastest Cycling Champion girls. Also at the end of the event, we would have crowned a best bicycle hip hop sound winner, a coolest bicycle contest winner, a best futuristic bike winner, and a cycling essay contest winner. ALL THESE WINNERS WILL BE FROM JUNIOR AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM OUR INNER CITIES. Money from the grant will be used as prize money, renting the tournament facility, purchasing equipment, marketing, and promoting the event. Refer to Appendix A in the attachment at the back of this proposal for a detailed description of expenditure allocations for the tournament.

The young people IC3 has identified and will be targeting with this racing meet and festival are good kids and hard working students. Unfortunately, due to their ethnicity, race, economic barriers, they are "AT RISK". Many of them are focusing their energies on drugs, gangs, and other caustic behavior early in life. IC3 is dedicated and committed towards improving the lives of these students. However, being dedicated and committed alone is not enough to execute an event such as this. Funding is required to make this tournament viable. Most of the participants that this racing meet and festival is targeting are economically disadvantaged and/or come from single family homes. Their families can't afford the costs associated with cycling (ie: equipment, clothing, tournament fees, etc). With this grant, IC3 will be able to execute this race meet and festival and show these inner city students that there is a positive, healthy, and financially rewarding alternative through cycling.

The goals and objectives of this racing meet and festival are as follows:

- 1) Familiarize inner city junior high and high school students, parents, and school administrators about cycling, its challenges, and its many rewards. Many inner city youths, their parents, and school administrators are simply not aware of cycling as an athletic career. They are only familiar with the career rewards of the main stream sports football, baseball, basketball, etc.
- 2) Expose the students, parents, and school staffs about health benefits of cycling.

- 3) Have Inner City Cycling Connection (IC3) experienced pro-cycling and semi pro-cycling staff shows the community safe cycling techniques and habits.
- 4) Identify potential cycling talents through the racing meets and start the development of those talents.
- 5) Assist in the development of school pride by having friendly amateur cycling races among schools.

## **BICYCLE RACING MEET AND FESTIVAL PARTICULARS AND REQUIEMENTS**

Invitations will be sent to all the middle and high schools within a 20 mile radius of the race meet and festival location. From these schools, Inner City Cycling Connection will select 20 junior high schools and 20 high schools to participate. Administrators from the selected schools will then select students to represent their school based on the requirements outlined below.

- 1) From the <u>iunior high schools</u>, one boy and one girl must be selected from the 7<sup>th</sup> grade, and two boys and two girls from the 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- 2) From the <u>high schools</u>, one boy and one girl must be selected from the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade, respectively. We did not include the 12 grader because they are seniors and will not be able to compete in subsequent years. IC3 wants to be able to gage and track our participants over the years as they matriculate from junior high to high school.
- 3) The students selected from the respective school <u>must</u> have a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average to compete.
- 4) Competing students <u>must</u> provide IC3 a doctor written note stating they are medical fit to perform a 200 meter sprint on a bicycle.

Through this selection method, we will have 60 junior high school students and 60 high school students entering the competition.

IMPORTANT NOTE: The racing bikes will be of the BMX type and will be provided by IC3. Secondly, IC3 professional staff will adjust the bike handle bar and seat to suit a particular student(s) height.

# **BICYCLE RACING MEET AND FESTIVAL STRUCTURE**

For both the junior high schools and high schools, boys will compete against boys and girls against girls; and respective grades will compete against each other (i.e.: 7<sup>th</sup> grade boy verses 7<sup>th</sup> grade boys, 10<sup>th</sup> grade boys, 9<sup>th</sup> grade girls verses 9<sup>th</sup> grade girls, etc.).

The racing meet will be structured by the round by round elimination method, similar to that of the **NCAA March Madness Final Four**. Each team will advance based on their <u>average</u> qualifying time per round. The team with the best <u>average</u> qualifying time after a round will be the one that advances.

The scenarios below illustrate this concept.



For scenario 2 depicted above, <u>High School Girls Team B</u> would have won round one and move on to round two. Conversely, scenario 2 could have represented the High School Team A and Team B Boys, respectively.

It is important to note that in the event of a tie in any round, IC3 will have a race-off in which the cyclists with the fastest times from each school in that round will compete against each other. The illustration below shows the order of progression for the tournament. It is an example of the final four standing of the competition.

## OTHER CONTESTS

To accommodate the non-cyclists, to encourage them to become cyclist, and to assist in the cultivation of other talents, IC3 developed other contests besides the racing meet. One is the hip hop cycling sound contest, another is the coolest bicycle contest, a third is a drawing contest, and the last is a cycling essay contest.

## **Hip Hop Cycling Sound Contest**

This contest will be open to all high school students within 20 miles of Julian C. Dixon Park. The particulars for this contest are as follows:

- 1) Participating students must come up with the hip hop lyrics for a bicycle sound.
- 2) The lyrics must revolve around cycling and Inner City Cycling Connection.
- 3) All lyrics must be clean.
- 4) Students can go to our website (www.innercitycycling.org) and other cycling website to acquire ideas to formulate their lyrics.
- 5) Written lyrics or a video of the student performing their sound must be emailed or YouTube to IC3 and our staff will decide on ten runner-ups to perform on the day of our bicycle race meet and festival.
- 6) Judges and the attending audience will decide on the first, second, and third place winners.
- 7) The first place winner will be awarded \$500, the second place winner \$250, and their place winner, \$75.

- 8) Besides the \$500, IC3 will give music studio recording time to the first place winner so his or her sound can be recorded professionally.
- 9) Contestant will be judged on creativity and originality.

## **The Coolest Bicycle Contest**

This contest will be open to all junior high and high school students within 20 miles of race meet and festival location. The particulars for this contest are as follows:

- 1) Students that think that they have a cool looking bike can bring it to our event
- 2) The bicycle our IC3 staffs deems to be the coolest wins \$300.

## **The Drawing Contest**

This contest will be open to all junior high and high school students within 20 miles of race meet and festival location. The particulars for this contest are as follows:

- 1) Students will draw and design a futuristic bicycle.
- 2) All design must be email to IC3 and our staff will decide on a first, second, and third place winner.
- 3) The first place winner will receive \$300, the second place winner \$200, and the third place winner, \$100
- 4) The crowning of the winner will occur on the day of the festival along with a display of their work.

## **An Essay Contest**

Like the other contests, this will be open up to all junior and high school students. To enter the contest, participating students must write a 1000 word essay or less based on the theme:

### WHAT DOES CYCLING MEAN TO THEM, THEIR COMMUNITY, AND THE WORLD?

The winning student will get \$500 and a chance to read their essay at our event.

## **OTHER EVENT HIGHLIGHTS**

Other events highlights will include a performance by the BMX bicycle team, a criterion race by our IC3 professional cyclists, live DJ and music, and vendor booths.


